The Legal Solution Suite for eDOCS RM by Matrix Logic consists of three add-on modules that provide Legal industry functionality to eDOCS RM and greatly enhances its use as an electronic records management solution for law firms. The suite consists of the following modules.

RMSynch – Can be used with InSynch by Matrix Logic to synchronize data elements from a Firm's Time & Billing system with the eDOCS RM File Plan. RMSynch will automatically create Client, Matter, Area of Law or Timekeeper Categories and Volumes in the eDOCS RM File Plan simultaneously as they are created in Time & Billing. RMSynch can be customized to synchronize almost any data element from a Firm's Time & Billing system with eDOCS RM.

ARCS (Automated Records Classification Service) – Automatically assigns individual electronic documents directly to the appropriate electronic folder or volume on the RM file plan. The entire ARCS process is run in the background and is totally transparent to users. DM users are not required to perform any additional steps to file documents to RM as they are being created, thus virtually guaranteeing documents are being filed properly and with the appropriate retention periods.

RPW (Retention Processing Workflow) – In conjunction with the standard Disposal or Transfer Processing functions of RM, RPW is a process to electronically distribute Disposal Reports and track Approvals or Denials for Destructions or Transfer processing. Attorneys or Managers within the firm can be notified via email that certain collections of documents have reached their specified retention dates. By clicking on the link within the email they are taken to a web page that lists the electronic, files, volumes and documents ready to be disposed of. At that point they have the option to Approve or Deny disposal of the entire batch or selectively tag certain volumes or documents to be excluded from destruction.
